Theft Recovery Software For Sony Ericsson



Introduction

Roblock is a theft recovery application for your Sony Ericsson mobile phone that protects it from theft/loss and helps to track it down. Roblock keeps track of the SIM changes of your device by sending SMS notifications to a predefined mobile number selected by the user. Roblock also recovers address book contacts stored on your device and reports the latitude and longitude of the current location of your device.



Installation

For installing this software on your device, you need the setup jar file on the phone. You can either download it using your phones web browser or by downloading on the PC and then transferring in to your phone through Bluetooth or Data cable.

Once the **roblock.jar** file reaches the phone, it asks whether to be installed into Games or Applications folder. Installing into the application folder is recommended. During installation you must accept the confirmations asked, and you must choose a location to install the application. Although the location can be either Phone Memory or Card memory, it is recommended to install the application of the phone memory for higher level of protection.

Once the installation is completed, you can run the application from the applications menu.



Initial Setup

When you run the application for the first time, a setup wizard asks you several settings required for the proper functionality of the software. You must accept any security questions asked, for the proper functionality of the application.

Password and Confirmation

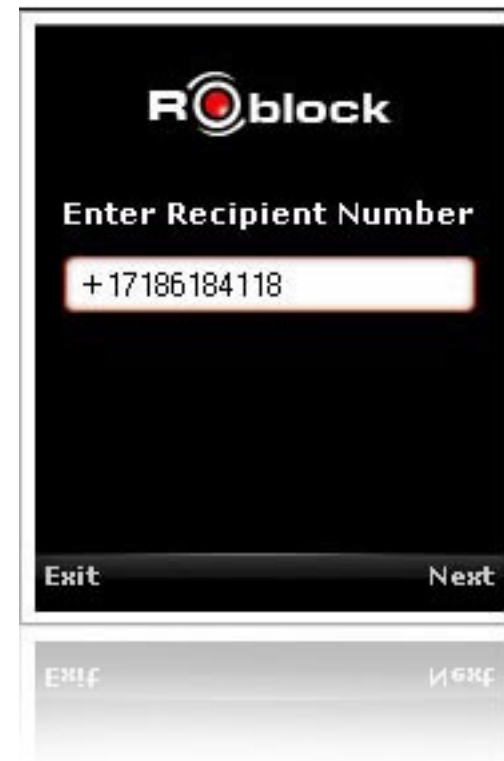
Roblock is password protected for preventing unauthorized access. You are asked to create a settings password during initial setup.

Recipient Number

This is the targeted secondary number to which the SIM change notification has to be sent. It is recommended that you inform the owner of the number about this setting.

Message

Here you can enter the text message that must be sent to your secondary number on SIM change.



Once you furnish the above details you are taken to the home screen of Roblock. You can change your application settings later using the Options menu.

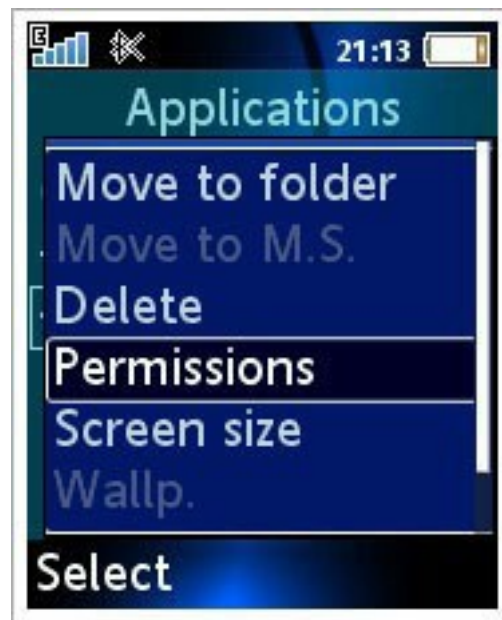
Registration

Roblock works for 3 days as trial version after which you need to purchase the product for protection of your device. A Product key will be provided upon purchase, which shall be entered into the application (Options>Register) to make it the fully functional registered version. While entering the Product Key into the application, please make sure phone is able to send and receive International SMS Messages.



Permission Settings

In order to ensure proper working of Roblock, you are required to enable the 'Auto Start', 'Messaging' and 'Read User Data' permissions. You can set the permissions by navigating to the Applications Menu of your phone, highlight the Roblock application, select the 'More' button, select Permissions and set the Auto Start, Messaging and 'Read User Data' settings to 'Never Ask' or 'Ask Once', whichever available. To ensure the settings are done correctly, you can try switching your device off and then back on, or preferably a SIM change, and there should be no confirmation messages shown at startup if the settings are properly configured.



Changing the SIM

If you are changing your number permanently to a new one, you need to do the following to inform Roblock about the change.

- ❖ Keeping the old SIM in your phone, open Roblock
- ❖ Deactivate Roblock by selecting Options>Disable
- ❖ Close the application and switch off the device
- ❖ Change the SIM and switch on.
- ❖ Open Roblock and select Options>Enable
- ❖ Exit Roblock.



Recovery Settings

Roblock can also recover your address book contacts and the cell tower location of the device, along with the SIM change notification. You can **enable/disable** these features from **Options > Recovery Settings**.



Handling a device theft

If your device installed with Roblock software gets stolen or lost, you must immediately inform the owner of the Recipient number about the chances of receiving a message from an unknown number stating the message you have entered in the settings. Once the new owner of your device changes the SIM card and switches on your phone, Roblock will silently send a message to the recipient number, which will reveal the new SIM number and thus the new owner's identity.

Based on your Recovery Settings, Roblock will also recover your address book contacts and the cell tower location of the device.



Uninstalling Roblock

If you want to uninstall Roblock from your phone, you can select the application and Select the **More > Delete** option on your device. It is recommended to restart your device after the removal of the software.
